COLONOSCOPY PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions at least 5 days prior to examination.

5 DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY - PLEASE REVIEW YOUR MEDICATIONS

- If you take Coumadin (or other anticoagulants) or Plavix (or other anti-platelet agents), you would typically hold these for 5 days prior to your colonoscopy. You should have been given specific instructions from your doctor(s) about how to manage these medications around the time of your procedure.
- If you take iron supplements (ferrous sulfate, ferrous gluconate, etc.) stop taking them.
- If you take daily aspirin to decrease your risk of cardiovascular disease, do NOT stop prior to colonoscopy.
- If you take oral medications for diabetes, take a half dose of your usual diabetes medications on the day of the prep and morning of the procedure. If you take insulin, you should have had an office visit and received specific instructions about how to manage your insulin around the time of your procedure.
- On the morning of your procedure, take all other morning medications at least 3 hours prior to your procedure.

3 DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

- Stop eating high fiber foods (seeds, nuts, whole grains, fibrous fruits and vegetables).
- If you are constipated, start taking MiraLAX 17g twice daily.

1 DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY.

• Drink only clear liquids. DO NOT eat any solid food or drink any liquids that you can't see through

Examples of allowed Clear Liquids

Water Gatorade

Apple Juice Soft Drinks (including coke & pepsi)

White Grape Juice Te

Chicken or Beef Bouillon Coffee (no milk, may use sweeteners)

Jell-0 Popsicles

Note: No Milk or Milk Products. No Red or Purple Colored Liquid

PREP A: Gatorlax- Purchase an 8 oz bottle of MiraLAX powder and a 10oz bottle of Magnesium Citrate over the counter from a pharmacy. You will also need two 32oz bottles of Gatorade (No Red or Purple)
The daybefore procedure, at 4:00 pm, drink the 10oz bottle of magnesium citrate.
At 6:00 pm. Mix half of MiraLAX (4 oz) in 32 oz of Gatorade and drink within 2 hours.
The day of your procedure, 5 hours before, Mix half of MiraLAX (4oz) in 32 oz of Gatorade and drink within 2 hours. If you feel sick, stop drinking the prep and then resume it when you feel better. Complete your price prep. Do Not drink anything 3 hours prior to procedure. This includes water

You are to have NOTHING BY MOUTH AT LEAST 3 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL. THIS INCLUDES WATER, GUM, MINTS, AND HARD CANDY. No oral tobacco product the day of your procedure. Failure to follow these instructions could results in postponing or rescheduling your procedure.

Your driver is required to be onsite for us to start the procedure and they MUST remain in the lobby for the duration of your procedure. You may not meet your ride in the parking lot. They need to be here to sign you out of the endo unit. Public transportation or taxicabs are NOT ALLOWED -unless you are accompanied by a responsible adult.

Please DO NOT apply any lotion, cologne or perfume prior to the procedure. For safety reasons please DO NOT wear any jewelry to your procedure and leave all valuables at home.

Our office will obtain a pre-authorization from your insurance company for your procedure; however, you are responsible to verify your insurance benefits. Please bring your insurance information and co-pay on the day of your procedure.

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
